A page on Scribe has been added that has the breakdown on features and pricing. Drea also showed the map of current KLAS installations and the section of the site honoring Julie Klauber award winners.

The site is mobile-friendly and responds to fit the screen.

The officers offered feedback and suggested some minor changes.
